HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS AND KILLINGS OF CIVILIANS BY UKRAINE'S TROOPS AND NATIONALIST ORGANISATIONS IN JULY-AUGUST 2024

Violations of human rights on the territory of the Donetsk People's Republic in the period from July 1, 2024 to August 31, 2024



On July 1, 2024, Ukraine's army shelled the Kuibyshevsky district of Donetsk (Isakova Str.)




On July 3, 2024, at 05:32, one of the HIMARS missiles **hit the First Republican Supermarket** in the Kievsky district of the city



On July 5, 2024, at 09:20 and 10:02, **Ukraine brutally attacked peaceful facilities** of Volnovakha. One of the HIMARS missiles pounded the territory of a developer company – **two peaceful inhabitanys were killed and four were injured**



Besides, several civilian vehicles sustained serious damage



On July 5, 2024, at 12:23, **the Ukrainian armed formations shelled civilian facilities** in the Leninsky district of Donetsk. **Two peaceful inhabitants were maimed** due to the direct HIMARS missile hit to a gas station

On July 7, 2024, the Ukrainian nationalists hit the Nikitovsky district of Gorlovka


From 1 to 8 July 2024, the Ukrainian military dealt 295 blows on civilian objects of the Donetsk People's Republic. The Donetsk direction sustained 107 assaults. Gorlovka was fired 181 times, Yasinovataya - thrice, Volnovakha - thrice, Svetlodarsk - once. A total of 894 units of different ammunition were used. Consequently, seven civilians were killed during the incessant shelling. 58 local residents, including two children (2011, 2016) and a teenager (2007) suffered injuries. As a result of the bombing, 55 residential buildings and 28 civilian facilities were harmed. In addition, 35 private cars sustained damage.



On July 9, 2024, **the armed formations of Ukraine hit residential buildings** in Donetsk's Petrovsky district, utilizing MLRS T-122



Horrific aftermath of the blow Ukraine's Grad multiple rocket launchers dealt against Gorlovka's downtown on July 11, 2024



On July 11, 2024, **the Ukrainian military launched a crushing strike on the housing stock** of the settlement of Krasny Partizan. Moreover, **a woman was killed** in the shelling



On July 12, 2024, **Ukraine dropped explosive device on a bus** (41st route) in the Kirovsky district of Donetsk, whereupon **several passengers sustained injuries**



On July 12, 2024, **Ukraine's army hit the housing stock** of Donetsk's Petrovsky district with multiple rocket launchers (Fedkovicha Str.). **One of the private houses caught fire**



On July 14, 2024, at 00:10, the Ukrainian nationalists assaulted the Kirovsky district of the city


From 9 to 15 July 2024, the Ukrainian troops shelled civilian infrastructure of peaceful settlements 257 times. 116 strikes hit the Donetsk direction. Gorlovka was pounded 137 times, Volnovakha - thrice, Yasinovataya - once. A total of 780 units of different ammunition were launched. Ukraine's attacks killed six civilians. In addition, 20 peaceful inhabitants, including two children (2012, 2010) sustained wounds. The bombs demolished 45 residential buildings. Besides, three cars, two shuttle buses and 13 civilian infrastructure facilities were damaged.



The Petrovsky district of Donetsk (Revyakina Str.) came under fire on July 20, 2024, at 05:30



Two local residents were killed in the shelling of Gorlovka on July 21, 2024



On July 22, 2023, at 11:45, the armed formations of Ukraine attacked Donetsk's Kievsky and Kalininsky districts. **A woman died** in the Kievsky district. In the other one, HIMARS missiles **destroyed the school No. 96, whereupon two teachers were injured**



On July 22, 2024, at 16:00, the Kirovsky district of Makeyevka (Yasinovka) came under fire of the Ukrainian nationalists - **housing stock and vehicles sustained damage**

From 16 to 23 July 2024, the Ukrainian armed formations mounted 259 attacks against civilian infrastructure of the Donetsk People's Republic. The Donetsk direction was shelled 110 times, Gorlovka - 143 times, Yasinovataya - six times. A total of 728 units of varied ammunition were utilized. Consequently, eight civilian infrastructure facilities came under Ukraine's fire. As a result of the barbaric bombing, ten civilians died. Moreover, 41 persons, including a teenager (2011), were maimed. 53 private houses sustained damage. Besides, sixteen passenger cars were hurt, one city bus mangled.



Ukraine's army struck at the Kievsky district of Donetsk on July 24, 2024, at 03:29



A man died, five locals were wounded in the shelling of Gorlovka on July 25, 2024



On July 28, 2024, **a Ukrainian FPV drone pounded a gas station** outside the Galaktika Shopping Mall in the Petrovsky district of Donetsk



FPV drone purposefully attacked a tram in Gorlovka's downtown on July 30, 2024. As a result of the attack, **a young guy, the train's driver, was killed**

From 24 to 31 July 2024, Ukraine's army dealt 254 blows on peaceful settlements housing no military facilities. The Donetsk direction was shelled 94 times, Gorlovka - 158 times, Yasinovataya - twice. A total of 740 units of different ammunition were launched. Consequently, five civilians died in the bombing. 24 people, including three kids (2006, 2007, 2016), were wounded. In addition, 23 residential buildings, 12 cars, a tram, two buses and two emergency vehicles sustained harm. Besides, significant damage was inflicted to 23 life-support facilities.



On August 2, 2024, at 10:35, the Ukrainian military attacked private houses in Volnovakha



Aftermath of Volnovakha shelling with the RM-70 Vampire MLRS and JROF HEF missiles containing a fragmentation part - **a civilian lost his live, another one was injured**



Ukraine's UAV smashed a gas station in the Kirovsky district of Donetsk on August 3, 2024



Ukrainian missiles demolished buildings in Makeyevka's downtown on August 4, 2024




A female civilian died in Gorlovka shelling on August 5, 2024

From 1 to 8 August 2024, the Ukrainian armed forces launched 251 strikes on civilian infrastructure of the Donetsk People's Republic. The Donetsk direction was assaulted 108 times, Gorlovka - 138 times, Yasinovataya - 4 times, Volnovakha - once. A total of 690 units of various ammunition were fired. Consequently, two peaceful inhabitants died in targeted attacks on residential neighborhoods. 31 civilians sustained varying degrees of injuries. Besides, the housing stock suffered heavy damage: 35 residential buildings were affected. In addition, eleven cars got mangled; six civilian facilities sustained damage.



On August 9, 2024, a Ukrainian FPV drone ruined several apartments in a residential building near the Donetsk City Shopping Mall in Donetsk's Kievsky district



Ukraine's army shelled Gorlovka's Centralno-Gorodskoy district on August 11, 2024



On August 10, 2024, **a man died and his wife went in an ambulance** after Ukraine's strike against the Kirovsky district of Donetsk (settlement of the Abakumov Mine, Kubanskaya Str.)



On August 10, 2024, the Ukrainian nationalists hit the Centralno-Gorodskoy district of Gorlovka with 155 Caesar artillery pieces



A 155 mm shell smashed a store in the Petrovsky district of Donetsk on August 12, 2024



Monstrous destruction after Ukraine shelled Gorlovka on August 14, 2024

From 9 to 15 August 2024, Ukraine's army struck at 181 civilian targets. 79 strikes hit the Donetsk direction. Gorlovka was assaulted 102 times. A total of 540 units of varied ammunition were utilized. As a result, projectiles affected 12 civilian infrastructure facilities. Furthermore, two civilians died during the shelling. 35 local residents, including a kid and two teenagers, were mutilated. Shell explosions damaged 38 residential buildings. Additionally, seven private vehicles and a bus were mangled.



On August 16, 2024, at 12:35, a Ukrainian projectile razed the 6th floor of an apartment building in the Petrovsky district of Donetsk (Dobrovolskogo Str., 1)



On August 16, 2024, **the Galaktika Shopping Mall also was severely damaged** during the bombing of the Petrovsky district. About 100 people remained inside the mall at the time of the attack. **More than six peaceful visitors sustained injuries**




On August 16, 2024, direct 155 mm shell hit **destroyed several floors in a nine-storey residential building** (Petrovskogo Str., 233)



Aftermath of the Seraphim Temple shelling in the Petrovsky district of Donetsk on August 18, 2024. A 155 mm shell hurt the administrative building of the temple complex



During the reiterated bombing of Donetsk's Petrovsky district on August 19, 2024, the armed forces of Ukraine **demolished a bus stop and smashed a city bus** (Dobrovolskogo Str.). In the wake of the attack, **a pregnant woman was killed and 10 people sustained injuries**



Ukraine's army assaulted residential areas of the Petrovsky district on August 20, 2024



On August 20, 2024, Ukraine shelled the Chervonogvardeysky district of Makeyevka, whereupon **several apartment buildings were destroyed** (Tukhachevskogo Str.)



Severe aftermath of an attack against Gorlovka's block 88 on August 22, 2024



On August 22, 2024, the Petrovsky district of Donetsk repeatedly came under fire of the Ukrainian nationalists. A 155 mm shell destroyed the apartment – a woman and a child were injured

From 16 to 22 2024, the Ukrainian military launched 165 strikes on peaceful settlements of the Donetsk People's Republic. The Donetsk direction was pounded 74 times, Gorlovka - 88 times, Dokuchaevsk - two times, Yasinovataya - once. A total of 501 units of various ammunition were fired. In the bombing of peaceful settlements, four civilians were killed. Moreover, 59 residents, including eight children (2007, 2008 (3), 2010, 2012, 2013, 2016) sustained injuries. Damage was caused to 46 residential houses. 9 cars, a tanker truck and 2 buses got mangled. In addition, 11 civilian facilities suffered harm.



The Ukrainian military assaulted Gorlovka's downtown on August 23, 2024



On August 27, 2024, 155 mm shell smashed a private house in the settlement of Pobeda (Gorlovka)



One civilian lost his life when the Ukrainian armed forces purposefully bombed Gorlovka's residential areas on August 29, 2024

From 23 to 31 June 2024, Ukraine attacked the civilian infrastructure of the Donetsk People's Republic 170 times. The Donetsk direction was shelled 63 times, Gorlovka - 105 times, Dokuchaevsk and Volnovakha - once each. A total of 521 units of varied ammunition were launched. As a result, shell explosions smashed 10 peaceful facilities. Besides, 4 civilians died and 26 were injured. Furthermore, 34 residential buildings sustained damage, four cars were disabled.

Human rights violations on the territory of the Lugansk People's Republic in the period from July 1, 2024 to August 31, 2024

In this timespan, the armed forces and nationalist formations of Ukraine continued to destroy civilian infrastructure in settlements of the Lugansk People's Republic (LPR) and commit war crimes against civilians. Peaceful inhabitants died under strikes of heavy NATO-supplied weapons. Many of civilians sustained serious injuries and were maimed. Targeted drone attacks on peaceful people and civilian objects have become the new normal for the Ukrainian military.

On July 1, 2024, an attack UAV crashed a transformer in Krasnorechenskoye.

The armed formations of Ukraine **assaulted a densely populated neighborhood** of Kremennaya on July 2, 2024. As a result, **four civilians sustained injuries; some windows of the nearby apartment buildings were shuttered**. Moreover, at about 19:50, **a drone attacked peaceful people** in the courtyard of the Kremennaya Hospital, whereupon **three persons, including two nurses, were maimed**.

On July 3, 2024, **the general gas pipeline was shattered** in Kremennaya shelling. **A male civilian** (1950) **sustained injuries** in Lisichansk.

On July 4, 2024, a woman (1953) was wounded in Kremennaya, a private house and several outbuildings got smashed.

Ukraine's army hit Pervomaisk on July 5, 2024. Seven civilians, including a sevenyear-old girl, were mutilated. One woman (1954) died in wounds later. In Zhitlovka (Kremennaya), a man (1951) was injured. One private house got damaged. In the shelling of Kremennaya, a woman (1979) was maimed. An apartment building, a private house, outbuildings, warehouses and garages sustained heavy damage.

On July 6, 2024, Kremennaya repeatedly came under fire of the Ukrainian military. **Two civilians** (1954, 1981) were wounded. Moreover, five private houses, outbuildings and two multi-storey buildings suffered damage. In Privolye (the Lisichansk district), Ukrainians attacked the neighborhood around the school No. 29.

On July 8, 2024, the Ukrainian armed formations pounded Kremennaya's downtown. At least 15 apartments of a multi-storey building were harmed. A medium-pressure gas pipeline and several power lines were disabled, whereupon residents in six streets lost power supply. An hour later, a neighborhood of private houses came under Ukraine's fire. Two peaceful inhabitants sustained injuries during this recurrent attack. 10 residential **buildings were damaged**. Besides, **rescuers of Russia's Ministry of Emergency Situations also were exposed to fire**; **a tanker truck was hurt**. **Three men** (1953, 1994, 1976) **sustained injuries** during another attack against the Central District Hospital. Consequently, **the premises of the hospital's surgical department were partially ruined**. In Privolye, **a psychiatric hospital, a five-storey house and a gas pipeline were hurt**.

On July 9, 2024, recurrent shelling of Kremennaya took place, whereupon about 15 residential buildings sustained damage. Additionally, low-, medium-pressure gas pipelines and power lines were disrupted. Moreover, significant damage was caused to Kremennaya's hospital. Three civilians, including a kindergarten employee, suffered injuries. In an attack against civilian infrastructure of Novovodyanoye (the Kremennaya district), a female civilian (1967) was maimed.

On July 10, 2024, the Ukrainian shells shattered two private houses and a car in Kremennaya. A man (1953) was killed during the shelling of the town's central market area on July 12, 2024. Local grocery store and an office of funeral services sustained damage. On July 13, 2024, four private houses, outbuildings and a car were smashed in one of the town's residential neighborhoods. On July 14, 2024, three outlets in the central market came under fire of the Ukrainian artillery pieces.

On July 15, 2024, there was recorded a reiterated attack by Ukraine against residential area of Lisichansk. A woman (1982) was injured.

On July 17, 2024, damage was inflicted to apartment buildings, state institutions, power and gas supply lines in Kremennaya.

On July 18, 2024, the Ukrainian armed formations struck at Svatovo, **damaging the general high-pressure gas pipeline**. Besides, **a low-pressure gas pipeline was shattered** in Novodruzhesk (the Lisichansk district).

On July 19, 2024, Ukraine's army attacked the settlement of Lugansk with three USmade ATACMS missiles. Local forest was set on fire by falling debris. Kremennaya also came under the Ukrainian onslaught, whereupon **state institutions, several shops and apartment buildings sustained damage**. In addition, **trade pavilions caught fire** in local market. After a while, **the nationalists utilized cluster munitions against first responders arriving on the scene to render help**. Consequently, **four men** (1982, 1970, 1997, 1981) **and three women** (1947, 1967, 1982) **were mutilated**.

One private house was damaged during Kremennaya shelling on July 20, 2024.

On July 21, 2024, the Ukrainian military launched UAVs onto Staraya Krasnyanka, whereupon a private house, a garage and a car were shattered. On the same day,

the settlement of Zhitlovka also was assaulted so that **a man** (1962) **and a woman** (1961) **suffered injuries; two residential buildings were harmed**. Besides, **two Gazel vehicles were mangled** in Lisichansk.

On July 22, 2024, a Ukrainian UAV hit an Audi100 car in Lisichansk.

Ukraine's army shelled the settlement of Lugansk on July 23, 2024. The military used two aircraft-type drones to attack residential areas. During the shelling of Kremennaya, a male civilian (1958) was injured; the Kremennaya State Forestry's equipment and one private house were harmed.

The Ukrainian troops repeatedly shelled Kremennaya on July 24, 2024. An attack UAV injured two male civilians (1988, 1964) and also damaged the facilities of the Kremennaya State Forestry.

On July 24, 2024, a boy (2018) suffered injuries by treading on the Lepestock mine in Lisichansk. The Ukrainian nationalists regularly scatter anti-personnel explosive devices throughout residential neighborhoods.

The Ukrainian military attacked Privolye on July 25, 2024. A female resident (1963) was hurt in the shelling of civilian infrastructure.

A UAV damaged one private car when Kremennaya repeatedly came under fire on July 26, 2024. Besides, **a Ukrainian drone killed a man** (1975) in Novodruzhesk.

On July 28, 2024, a UAV mutilated a female civilian (1961) in Lisichansk. Her apartment was severely damaged. Windows were broken in several blocks of the house. That day, a man (1948) sustained injuries in the shelling of Kremennaya's residential neighborhood. One private house was damaged as well.

Kremennaya recurrently came under Ukraine's fire on July 29, 2024. A private house was shattered. In Privolye (the Lisichansk district), an attack UAV set a building on fire.

On July 31, 2024, the Ukrainian army hit Krasny Luch with two ATACMS missiles. **Two windows and a metal fence outside a private household were damaged** in the shelling of Svatovo's residential infrastructure. **Ukraine's UAV assaulted a civilian car** on the N-26 highway (the Svatovo district), **killing a peaceful inhabitant** (1986). Moreover, **a high-voltage cable was damaged at the Redkie Gazy Plant** in Lisichansk.

On August 1, 2024, the Ukrainian nationalists dealt a blow on Kremennaya. **An apartment building was damaged** in one of the town's residential areas. Besides, a UAV attacked a motorcycle, **injuring two local residents** (2004, 2002). In Svatovo, **a Ukrainian drone purposefully smashed a civilian minibus, having traumatized a man** (1958), **a woman** (1986) **and her 10-year-old daughter**. On August 3, 2024, a UAV deliberately attacked a civilian car in Svatovo, **injuring a male civilian** (1965). In the shelling of Kremennaya's residential areas, **local boarding school was affected**. Moreover, **a Ukrainian drone maimed a man** (1961) in Lisichansk.

On August 4, 2024, the Ukrainian troops shelled the settlement of Lugansk with Western-made missiles (8 ATACMS and 4 Storm Shadow missiles). About 30 residential buildings sustained damage: shrapnel smashed roofs and glazing of houses, as well as several cars, fences, power lines and warehouses. In addition, four private houses were damaged in Kremennaya.

On August 5, 2024, the armed formations of Ukraine repeatedly hit Kremennaya, **damaging one electrical substation** within a residential area. On August 8, 2024, **a civilian** (1968) **died and another one** (1980) **was injured; three private houses were shattered**.

A Ukrainian UAV attacked Novaya Krasnyanka (the Kremennaya district) on August 6, 2024 - **damage was inflicted to two electric transformers**.

On August 8, 2024, a Ukrainian UAV deliberately assaulted a peaceful car in Kremennaya. A man (1995) and a woman (1973) sustained injuries. Moreover, a 13-year-old teenage girl was seriously injured by the explosion of a cluster munition hitting her courtyard. A private house was hurt.

In the shelling of Kremennaya on August 9, 2024, **the City Hospital's windows were partially blown out, two ambulances damaged**. Besides, **a female civilian** (1968) **was injured. An attack UAV smashed a private house and a car**.

On August 10, 2024, a Ukrainian UAV damaged one private house in Kremennaya.

On August 12, 2024, one more drone struck at the LPR Post's vehicle on the Novonikolskoye-Svatovo roadway, heavily mangling the car's body. In Molodogvardeysk (the Krasnodon district), two boys (2014) were mutilated due to detonation of a previously unexploded shell. During the shelling of Kremennaya's residential areas, three women (1948, 1952, 1973) sustained injuries. In addition, one private house was damaged.

A Ukrainian UAV hit a civilian car in the settlement of Privolye on August 13, 2024. A woman (1960) was killed. Moreover, cluster munitions murdered three civilians in Lisichansk. Besides, 28 people, including a 12-year-old child, were injured. In Kirovsk, an electric substation was broken so that numerous inhabitants of the town totally lost power supply. In Kremennaya, a UAV wounded a teenager (2012); a private house was damaged. On August 14, 2024, the Ukrainian armed formations assaulted Novonikolsk (the Kremennaya district), whereupon a UAV smashed one private house; a man (1982), and a woman (1977) were wounded. In Kremennaya, an attack drone hurt a private house.

Kremennaya recurrently came under fire of the Ukrainian military on August 17, 2024. An attack UAV flew into a window of the Malyutka Kindergarten and caused significant damage to the building. In Zhitlovka (the Kremennaya district), a woman (1942) sustained injuries; a private house was damaged.

On August 18, 2024, Ukraine's army struck at Privolye (the Lisichansk district), whereupon **a UAV mutilated a woman** (1978).

On August 19, 2024, a Ukrainian drone smashed one private house in Kremennaya. On August 20, 2024, a man (1951) suffered wounds in the shelling; a private house and a road bridge over the Krasnaya River were smashed.

The Ukrainian military attacked the settlement of Zhitlovka on August 20, 2024. A man (1959) was maimed and a private house was damaged.

The Ukrainian nationalists repeatedly struck at Kremennaya on August 21, 2024. A UAV smashed a private house and a car. In Svatovo, a drone deliberately attacked a civilian vehicle and mutilated a man (1987).

On August 22, 2024, Ukraine's army hit Kremennaya, damaging 4 private houses.

A woman (1932) sustained injuries in the bombing of Lisichansk on August 25, 2024. A day later, a male civilian (1959) was killed and one woman (1953) was wounded.

On August 26, 2024, Ukraine struck the residential infrastructure of Kremennaya.

Staraya Krasnyanka (the Kremennaya district) came under fire of the armed forces of Ukraine on August 27, 2024. Significant damage was inflicted to three private houses, outbuildings and a car belonging to the Ministry of Emergency Situations. A woman (1968) was injured in Lisichansk.

In the shelling of the residential infrastructure of Kremennaya on August 28, 2024, a private house and a garage were harmed.

On August 29, 2024, Ukraine's army shelled Novodruzhesk (the Lisichansk district). **A woman** (1944) **was injured** during the bombing.

Three private houses were damaged in Kremennaya on August 31, 2024.

Human rights violations against peaceful inhabitants of the Kherson region in the period from July 1, 2024 to August 31, 2024

During this period, Ukraine's army mounted more than 25 massive attacks, firing over 1,500 artillery shells at civilian infrastructure facilities. As a result, 50 people sustained varying degrees of injuries.

The Ukrainian armed formations daily assault populated areas of the Kherson region with various types of weapons, including cluster munitions. Life support facilities and civilians, medical and civilian vehicles transporting humanitarian aid to affected settlements, as well as first responders fixing aftermath of explosions regularly come under fire. Such moves committed by the Ukrainian side directly violate the provisions of the Geneva Convention Relative to the Protection of Civilian Persons in Time of War.

The armed forces of Ukraine undertake systematic attempts to destroy energy infrastructure that satisfies needs of the civilian population. As a result of these attacks, over twenty major power outages occurred during the specified period (about five thousand subscribers lost power supply each time). Nationalists also purposefully assault civilian infrastructure.

On August 12, 2024, the Ukrainian military hit the Vodokanal Enterprise in the town of Kakhovka. In the wake of this terrorist attack, **one of the company's employees, a man** (1981), **sustained shrapnel wounds to head**. Moreover, **the Vodokanal Enterprise's professional equipment was damaged** as well.

On August 29, 2024, the servicemen of Ukraine's army committed one more egregious crime against humanity: five FPV drones purposefully attacked the Alyoshki Central District Hospital. As a result, a nurse was injured. In addition, the hospital's facilities, including the children's department and an operating room, were damaged.

Human rights violations against peaceful inhabitants of the Bryansk region in the period from June 1, 2024 to August 31, 2024

The Ukrainian nationalists mounted 69 targeted attacks against civilian infrastructure and peaceful inhabitants. Unlike to previous months, their attacks have become systematic. As a result, significant damage was inflicted to the housing stock, vehicles and peaceful energy facilities of the region. The most egregious crimes were onslaughts against populated areas, which injured and maimed local residents.

On July 17, 2024, from 12.00 to 14.00, the armed forces of Ukraine dealt an artillery blow on the settlement of Zernovo (the Suzemka district). Detonation of the artillery munition **injured a teenage girl** (2010) who received **a concussion and abrasions of her left forearm**. Moreover, **direct projectile hit completely destroyed one private house** (Molodezhnaya Str., 31). In addition, **fragments of artillery ammunition inflicted damage to three households** (Tsentralnaya Str., 60; Molodezhnaya Str., 29, 41).

On July 25, 2024, a Ukrainian UAV attacked the outskirts of the village of Chausy (the Pogar district) and **damaged a Kirovets agricultural tractor** (property of the Kolkhoznik Co.), which was working in a field. **The tractor's driver** (1966) **got a concussion**.

On August 9, 2024, at about 11:00, the Ukrainian military struck at the settlement of Sluchovsk (the Pogar district). Ukraine's FPV drone hit courtyard of the private house (Pervomaiskaya Str., 48), whereupon **the household was damaged and a Lada Kalina car caught fire**. In addition, **with a targeted repeated attack, another UAV inflicted bodily injuries on a neighbor woman** who raised the alarm due to the fire. **The female civilian** (1964) **sustained a mine explosion injury, shrapnel wound to the soft tissues of the nape, facial tissues, right shoulder and shoulder joint, as well as the 5th finger of the right hand.**

On August 13, 2024, from 09.50 to 11.50, eight FPV drones assaulted the settlement of Brovnichi (the Klimovsk district). A GAZ Gazelle Next bus, a road train (a Volvo car with a tanker truck), as well as DAF and KAMAZ trucks were damaged due to detonation of explosive devices. In addition, one civilian (1970) was mutilated (mine explosion injury, closed craniocerebral injury and concussion, trauma of the ears, shrapnel wounds of the soft tissues of the trunk, left shoulder and left hip).

On August 27, 2024, at about 17.55, the armed formations of Ukraine launch a strike on the settlement of Kurkovichi (the Starodubsk district). A Ukrainian UAV flew into a private house, inflicting extensive fire (Oktyabrskaya Str., 52). Later the flame spread to a neighboring garage (Oktyabrskaya Str., 54). The Ukrainian nationalists purposefully attacked firefighter brigade that arrived to extinguish the combustion. One of the firefighters suffered a mine explosion injury, concussion, shrapnel wounds to his head, abdomen and arms. The explosion stunned the chief of the municipal district administration and his driver, who ended up at the scene of the fire.

On August 31, 2024, from 08.00 to 09.44, Kirillovka (the Klimovsk district) came under attack of Ukrainian FPV drones. **An elderly woman** (1941) **and a man** (1964) **sustained injuries due to detonation of explosive devices** (shrapnel wounds to the soft tissues of the abdomen and lower extremities). The fire completely destroyed a VAZ- 2109 car (Sadovaya Str., 81). **A transformer substation belonging to ROSSETICENTER - Bryanskenergo Co. was damaged** as well.

VIOLATION OF FREEDOM OF CONSCIENCE IN UKRAINE. VIOLENCE AGAINST THE UKRAINIAN ORTHODOX CHURCH OF THE MPSCOW PATRIARCHATE



The Verkhovna Rada (parliament) of Ukraine has effectively sanctioned to ban the Ukrainian Orthodox Church (UOC) in the country

On August 20, 2024, the Ukrainian deputies passed law **banning the Ukrainian Orthodox Church (UOC), which is the largest Christian denomination and believers' community in the country**. The bill was signed by President Vladimir Zelensky on August 24, 2024. It actually contradicts the basic international legal norms and tramples on the basic human rights enshrined in the constitution of Ukraine.

Members of the HRC Permanent Commission on international cooperation in the field of human rights have appealed to the world's spiritual leaders, representatives of traditional religious denominations and international human rights organizations to hinder the arbitrariness of the Ukrainian authorities, prevent the law from coming into force and stop crackdown on of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church.
